Beinn Eighe Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) is an extensive mountain massif located to the south of Loch Maree and south west of Kinlochewe in Wester Ross The rocks of Beinn Eighe comprise a sequence from ancient Lewisian gneiss up through younger Torridonian sandstone and a succession of Cambrian sedimentary rocks
